- Agreement renewal letter between SCTV & The Town of Saugus; Bryan will send an email to BOS that SCTV is requesting to be put on the next Board of Selectmen agenda for the following 2 items:

First is for appropriation of funds for our approved FY2022 Operations Budget. First quarterly payment should be made in July.

Second is to start the "request to renew the agreement between The Town of Saugus and SCTV". Our current agreement expires in January 2022 and states we must give notice to the selectmen 6 months prior. SCTV wants to make sure this request to renew is acknowledged.

- Anthony Moschella had a conversation with board members to discuss an hourly pay increase, Donna and Jim asked the board to discuss this at the next meeting to address Anthony's concerns about his position at SCTV.
